
Minimize Plastic Waste - Awareness Campaign



Induction Ceremony




Flood Relief Collection center


Independence Day Celebration


Visit To Vallathol Nagar Grama Panchayath


About the project




The students started coming to the registration desk by 9:00 am. After the registration they were guided towards the college auditorium where the official function was to be held.
